

## **Orphan Bunny Formula**

**1 cup Pet Evaporated Milk  
10 drops Vi-Sorbin (a vitamin-mineral supplement)  
2 egg yolks  
1 tablespoon Karo Syrup  
1 tablespoon Corn Oil  
1 pinch of salt**

**Mix to blend uniformly and feed 3 times a day. Feed with a syringe without the needle, and allow the bunny to suck the formula out. A supplement called BeneBac can be obtained from your Veterinarian. Give ½ gram every other day to aid in digestion.**

**Keep your baby rabbit warm and comfortable. It's a good idea to put some grass (add fresh grass daily) and a towel in the cardboard box as his home. Start feeding rabbit pellets to your rabbit at 2 weeks of age. Even though baby bunnies are adorable, soft, warm and cuddly; their chance of survival are directly proportionate to how little they are handled. Please hold them ONLY when feeding. Let him go back to "The Woods" at 4 weeks of age.**

**These instructions are intended for wild orphan rabbits, however it works as well with domestic rabbits. With domestic rabbits, feed for 3-5 weeks, or until they are consuming enough rabbit pellets to equal at least 1 ounce per pound of rabbit. However, a young, growing bunny can easily eat twice this amount.**
